Learn about organic growing practice while helping ensure a bountiful harvest for students and community. No experience necessary - both heavy and light work available at all work parties. Tasks may include: digging, hauling & spreading wood chips or compost, weeding, planting seedlings, harvesting & washing produce and starting seeds in germination trays. Dates available to help are Fridays, July 19, July 26, and August 2, (9:00-Noon). Our work will be lead by Georgia Paulk, who is the garden coordinator (a Univ. of Portland social justice program student/employee). Her mom Linda and hopefully other volunteers will work up a sweat outside of the club. Please wear comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing you don't mind getting dirty and closetoed shoes. Light snacks & drinking water will be provided, but please bring your own water bottle!

Pool News







Barney Giansante's 92nd Birthday!


On June 19th, club member Barney Giansante celebrated turning 92 with some friends and family here at the club. Happy Birthday Barney!
