Tasks may include: digging, hauling & spreading wood chips or compost, weeding, planting seedlings, harvesting & washing produce and starting seeds in germination trays. Dates available to help are Fridays, July 19, July 26, and August 2, (9:00-Noon). Our work will be lead by Georgia Paulk, who is the garden coordinator (a Univ. of Portland social justice program student/employee). Her mom Linda and hopefully other volunteers will work up a sweat outside of the club. Please wear comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing you don't mind getting dirty and close-toed shoes. Light snacks & drinking water will be provided, but please bring your own water bottle!

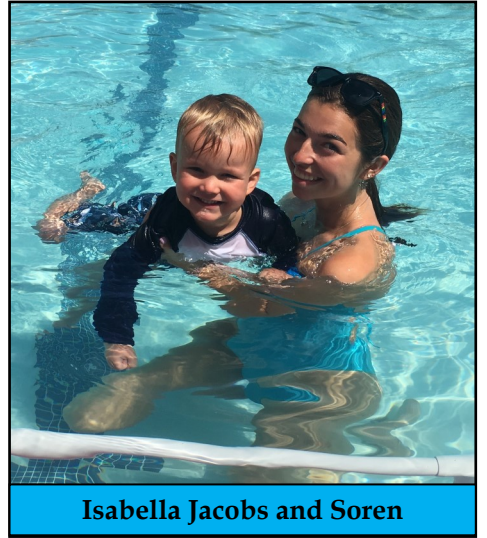

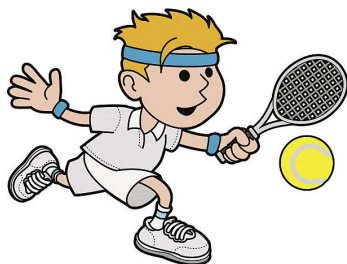

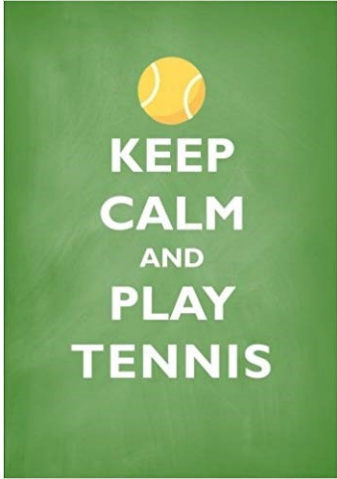
