Congrats to Donna Roisom on receiving the lifetime sport achievement & leadership award! As a Pioneer Athlete, Donna was undefeated in tennis playing Number 1 singles and finished first in NCWSA. She was a member of the Championship Team as well as the All Star Tennis Team. She was also a member of the women's basketball All Star Honorable Mention Team and Championship Team. Her collective sports experiences resulted in 10 letters out of 12 seasons during her College tenure. Upon graduating, Donna has received the District Coach of the Year for Girls in 1997, and for Boys in 1998, 1999, 2002, and 2005. She received State couch of the year for Boys in 2002 and for Girls in 2018. She also received Sectional Coach of the Year for Boys in 2002 and for Girls in 2018. Since 2016, Donna has coached the Grant High School Girls Tennis Team.

## Community Committee Member Spotlight—Anne Hicks



Anne Hicks, Rose Haven Volunteer

I recently sat down with Anne Hicks after a tour of the Rose Haven Shelter for Women and Children, a safe place for women, children, and gender diverse clients experiencing trauma of abuse, loss of home, or other disruptive challenges. The Center was bustling with women and children on the morning that I visited. There was a line to sign up for clothing, social services and resources, a buffet for meals, and a nurse offering health services in a mini-clinic right next to the clothing shop. Upstairs from the small cramped basement location, there are showers for daily use and a Rec room for Classes and Activities.

Anne has been a volunteer in the clothing store every Tuesday morning for the last eight years. Anne is perfectly matched to help the clients find clean, quality clothing basics, shoes, and toiletries. Women are allowed to pick out 5 items for both themselves and up to 2 children every 30 days. Her kind, considerate, and respectful manner gives support to the women who come in for help and are in search of stability. 3,500 clients are served annually.

Anne first became interested in Rose Haven after several years of volunteering with her 3 daughters through the National Charity League. Of all the programs they had been involved with, Rose Haven struck a chord, the philosophy resonated with her as it was outside her box; she felt like *she could make a difference*. Over the years, Anne has seen the type of clients change, reflecting the increase in homelessness and poverty. A 2018 report states Portland has had a 16% rise in homeless women and an 86% rise in women and children seeking help at Rose Haven. In one case, Anne recalls serving three generations in one family. Another story she shared was of a woman she followed over the years who was able to gain enough support to become sober, find an apartment and a steady job. She sees it as a marathon, not a sprint, in making changes in their lives. Her reward is that at *that moment she can help someone in need and create change*. Anne does make a difference and it also shows in the camaraderie she has with clients and staff who value her team work in making the clients feel nurtured and cared for. She keeps showing up and has been counted on for all these years.

Join us at The Irvington Club in a Holiday Donation Drive. We've been offered the chance to participate in the Children's Holiday Party which has grown so big, they now hold it in a downtown hotel. Here's an opportunity to give to a community that is on the edge. When you see Anne next, give her kudos on the strong commitment she has had with Rose Haven. The Volunteer Coordinator values Anne's work; she has been dedicated and is seen as an asset to Rose Haven.
