Help support The Portland Backpack Project

Join the Community Involvement Committee to support The Portland Backpack Project: July and August 2022

We invite members of the Irvington Club to donate cash and/or food again for this very worthwhile program that sends food home weekly with students in several NE Portland schools. For many children, free school meals are their only reliable food each day. On the weekends these children often don't have the food that they need. The backpacks packed by volunteers go home with the children each Friday so they have food over the weekend.

From the director of the PBP, "Portland Backpack was able to relieve hunger in Portland during the pandemic in unprecedented ways. In the last school year, we distributed 10,615 food sacks and \$486,615 in grocery gift cards to kids and families at ten PPS schools. I want to thank the Irvington Club for helping to make this happen.

Pre-pandemic we were serving 340 kids a weekend at 4 schools and this fall because of community response like from Irvington Club, we will be serving 1000 kids a weekend at the ten schools. That should be about 20,000 weekends when a kid has the food that they need to thrive. Thank you so much for helping us make these worry-free weekends possible."

Monetary donations are welcome at the website or members can leave cash at the front desk. Please note that \$24 will feed 4 kids food for a week, \$216 will feed a kid for an entire school year, a monthly donation of \$18/month will feed 1 kid for the entire school year, and \$100/month will feed 200 kids for every weekend during the school year!

There are specific foods requested for the backpacks:

Protein: Soups: Chicken Noodle or Beef Stew from Healthy Soups, Progresso soup- low salt, Amy's soup, canned tuna, chicken, ravioli with meat, chili w/ or w/o meat, Mac & Cheese - No ramen noodles or condensed soup.

Fruit: Pears, peaches, pineapple, mixed fruit in light syrup or no added sugar.

Oatmeal: Any flavor of individual packs of Instant oatmeal packages.

Snacks: Granola bars, fruit bars, small boxes of raisins, breakfast bars, small box of nuts or trail mix - Avoid peanuts, and snacks with high sugar.

Food lists will be available at front desk to take to the store.

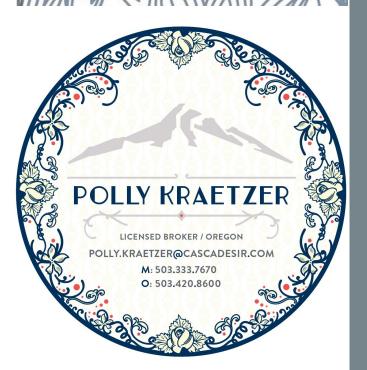
