Congrats to this year's new honorary members: Sam Vranizan and Cristobal Valverde.

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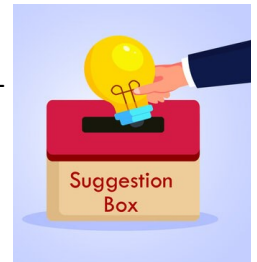
### *New 120 Club Members*
