Dear Irvington Club Members,

Last month I listed three short-term priorities for our club over the course of Beth's first year: tennis programming, utilizing our spaces, and producing a new Irvington Club Member Guide to replace the old directory. Work continues on all those fronts.

We are now moving into a focused period where our Strategic Planning Team, led by Board member Bill Malloch, will be developing recommendations for a three-year strategic plan. This begins later this summer with a Board of Trustees retreat where your Board members will meet with consultant Amy Winkelman to establish our long-term strategic priorities. We will be using data on court utilization, membership data, financial records, input from committees, and, of course, member contributions in the form of your suggestions and results from the recent member survey to establish those priorities. After the retreat, the Strategic Planning Team will use the board established long-term priorities to write a draft plan that includes the details and timeline for carrying out those priorities. Their draft will then come to the Board for approval. This is important and necessarily meticulous work. We have a tentative goal of completing this plan in time to hand it to the new Board and present it to members at the end of this fiscal year (next February). That is an aspirational goal which could be derailed as unforeseen obstacles present themselves. But we will hold onto it as long as we can.

It is a pleasure to be serving you as president of our club. Thank you for your continued support and input as we forge ahead in making the Irvington Club an even more welcoming, vibrant, and fun community.

Black Swimming Initiative (BSI) Fund Raiser

The Community Involvement Committee with the support of The Board of Trustees has invited the Black Swimming Initiative (BSI) organization to hold its fund raiser at the Pool on July 29th from 12:00-3:00PM. The BSI's mission is to expand meaningful participation in water sports by providing a strong sense of belonging for Black athletes of all backgrounds, abilities and lifestyles by supporting safe and accessible water safety and swimming instruction. The BSI's vision is a world where racism is eliminated from aquatics and water sports; where individuals can access bodies of water with confidence in themselves and be welcomed by all.

Black Swimming Initiative hosts one, free swim event per month teaching water safety, drowning prevention and swim skills to ages 6 months and older. Its target audience is the black community; however, everyone is welcome. September through June, our events are held in indoor pools, but we move to the open water in July and August. We typically host around 40-50 participants per event and provide goggles, swim caps, swim suits and lifejackets to anyone who needs them.
