### President's Message

Dear Irvington Club Members,

I have a larger number of things to share than usual. I will be as brief as possible.

- Our manager, Beth Moore, will remain on leave until later in November. We send her our best wishes for a rejuvenating recovery.
- I want to take a moment to appreciate the Irvington Club staff. They have all stepped into the void left by having no manager overseeing the day-to-day operations and have kept things running smoothly at the Club. Please remember to take a moment to thank them when at the Club.
- We are winding down the expanded pool season. We are happy to have been able to
  do that for our members this year. Our pool committee will be taking a look back at this
  season to take stock of what worked well and what improvements can be made next
  year. If you are a pool user and would like to give input, Jenny MacNichol (chair) and
  Cathy Porter (Board representative) will be sharing opportunities for you to do that
  soon.
- Our tennis court use is going up again as it always does as we move into the fall season. It is great to see you all out playing and having fun. Much of our tennis attention is focused on the Carolyn Lumber Tournament. There are many people stepping up to make sure it will be the best ever. I thank them all for their commitment! The tournament will be later in the month this year. It was moved to the end of the month out of respect to our members who have difficulties playing during the Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur holidays that take place over the first two weeks of October.
- Thank you to the nearly 300 people who filled out the Irvington Club Facilities
  Renovation Survey. You gave the committee great data that shows that there is
  definitely an appetite for facilities upgrades! More details will be shared as we move to
  the next stages of the process.
- The pickleball mediation team continues to work on reconciliation with our neighbor. To that end, we hired a certified acoustical engineer to come and conduct a noise study that compares normal tennis noise to normal pickleball noise and also pickleball with quiet paddles and quiet balls. This data will help in our next mediation session. Unfortunately, scheduling many busy people is challenging and that means the mediation won't happen until November. We continue to have the goal of reaching a mutually acceptable agreement that gets our members back out on the courts for pickleball in 2025. In the meantime, you can use that court for tennis, hitting on the backboard, and spec tennis.


